### CMS Informal Review Deadline Extended

CMS has extended the deadline for informal review of 2016 Physician Quality Reporting System (PQRS) and Value-Based Payment Modifier (VM) to **11:59 pm on November 23, 2015**.

If you have reviewed your 2014 AQRUR and think that:

- you have been incorrectly assessed the 2016 PQRS negative payment adjustment (-2.0% of 2016 Medicare FFS payments) OR
- there is a perceived error in your 2016 VM calculation (applicable to groups of 10+ Eligible Professionals as identified by Tax ID Number/TIN)

you can submit an informal review request for CMS to investigate your incentive eligibility and/or payment adjustment determination.

Submit your request through the [Quality Reporting Communication Support Page \(CSP\)](#). All informal review requestors will be contacted via email of a final decision by CMS within 90 days of the original request for an informal review. **All decisions will be final and there will be no further review.**
