- 12 RESOLVED, that the study would examine existing forensic mental health care structures by
- 13 both reviewing existing literature and conversation and through collaboration with forensic
- 14 mental health leadership in other states. The study findings would be synthesized to produce
- 15 specific treatment and management recommendations for 1) individuals found not guilty by
- 16 reason of insanity (insanity acquittees) and 2) recommendations for competency restoration for
- 17 individuals found not competent to stand trial.
