5 6	RESOLVED, that VMS support the distribution of evidence-based information to the public and clinicians regarding cannabidiol (CBD), including potential health risks of its use such as
7 8 9	increased hepatoxicity and drug interactions; and be it further RESOLVED, that VMS oppose and work to increase enforcement against the false advertising of
10 11	non-FDA approved CBD for therapeutic or medical purposes, and be it further
12 13 14	RESOLVED, the VMS support enforcement of current federal law under which CBD is only available as an FDA-approved drug; and be it further
15	RESOLVED, that VMS support regulation of the manufacture of CBD that protects human
16 17	health including requirements that it be free of contaminants including mold, heavy metals and pesticides; has reliable active drug concentration of cannabidiol; that it contain no more than
18 19	trace amounts (0.3% or less) of tetrahydrocannabinol (THC); that it not be added to food, especially that is attractive or appealing to children; and that it not be fed to livestock.
